

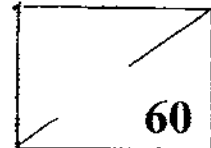

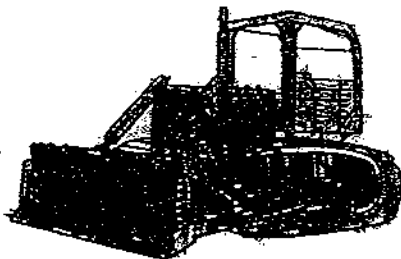

That night, while the old man was sleeping, all the workers left the house quietly. The next morning, the old man yelled for his workers but no one turned up anymore.

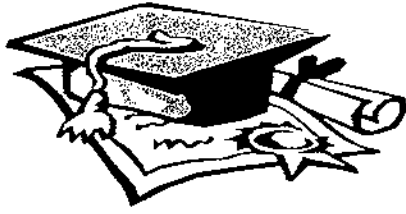

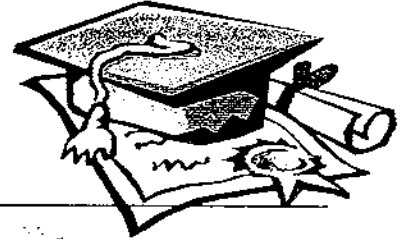
