<p>Leonardo da Vinci was born in 1452 Vinci, Italy. As a child, Leonardo loved spending time in nature, where his curiosity grew. As a teenager, he moved to Florence, Italy, to study art, where he began his painting lessons. He learnt to mix coloured powder with egg yolk and water, to create paint.</p>	
<p>Leonardo was not just an artist, he was an inventor. He wrote nearly 20,000 pages of notes filled with ideas, observations and inventions. One of his unusual habits was backward writing, where all the letters were reversed. As such, it was harder for others to read his notes. This might had helped to keep his ideas safe.</p>	5
<p>Among his many inventions, Leonardo sketched designs for a flying machine. He was one of the first people to seriously study human flight. When the Duke of Milan asked him to paint a mural for his palace, Leonardo painted "The Last Supper", the <u>artwork</u> that first helped him gain fame.</p>	10
<p>Leonardo also began work on the <i>Mona Lisa</i>, a painting famous for its smile and eyes that seem to follow the viewer. Later, Leonardo moved to Amboise, France and became the official painter for the King. He spent the rest of his life there, continuing to create, learn, and inspire generations with his brilliance.</p>	15




